This Apprenticeship will help you develop your skills as an Early Years Practitioner. You will gain experience in an early years settings. In their daily work, an employee in this occupation interacts with parents, children, colleagues and wider multi-agency professionals and partners such as health visitors, social workers and speech and language therapists.

Individuals will undergo all checks as per the EYFS requirements to ensure suitability to work with children.
